<p>What is your cartoon about? What current issue or political topic are you referencing?</p>	<p>My cartoon is about how homeless people usually face discrimination, or are usually shamed when seen asking for money at the side of the road. Passersby would usually show little sympathy towards the homeless people, and most would walk pass without acknowledging them. Whereas for stray dogs, passersby would usually acknowledge the dog's presence, and figure out how to help them in any way. It is not uncommon for people to feed stray animals, while it is quite uncommon for people to help homeless people.</p>

What are your comments/criticisms?</p>	<p>Although more people would approach a stray animal, rather than a homeless person, it is still important to help whoever is in need of help. However, it is important for people to be able to help poorer or homeless people as they can be struggling a lot to support themselves. As the society of having a stable job that can support oneself is normalized, it might not be very easy for everyone to achieve it. Though it is not required for any individual to help a homeless person find a job, giving them a little still goes a long way, such as paying for a meal or giving them a small amount of money. People should not treat homeless people and stray animals unequally, as each individual has the same goal to be able to survive and to be able to support themselves.</p>

This cartoon shows the contrast between the treatment towards stray animals, and people who cannot afford living in a house. This shows how people would care more about animals that they see and do not know, more than people that are struggling to find jobs and a place to live.</p> <p>Another technique that I have used is irony, demonstrating how people would not be</p>

willing to help other people as much, compared to animals. This emphasizes the difference between the treatment of stray animals and homeless people.
